THIRD PARTY OPPORTUNITIY: GENETICS WORKSHOP

The Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR) Institute of Genetics is <u>planning a</u> <u>workshop</u> to bring together patients living in Canada to help ensure patient and caregiver voices are heard and guide our future work. At the workshop, participants will discuss best practices in patient engagement in genetics research, focusing on equity, diversity, and inclusion.

CIHR is looking for patients and caregivers with lived experience of an inherited condition to participate in the workshop. They are especially interested in hearing from patients and caregivers who have not been engaged in research before.
