

PROJECT REQUEST GUIDELINES FOR USING ELEVATE

Are you looking to gain perspectives from the Canadian cystic fibrosis community through a project that you are conducting? Elevate can help you get connected to the audience you seek.

WHAT IS ELEVATE?

Elevate is CF Canada's volunteer initiative that places the CF community's voices and experiences at the center of our work. It enables Canadians diagnosed with cystic fibrosis and their families to share their experiences, perspectives, and priorities, to help guide cystic fibrosis research, care, support and programs.

WHAT ARE SOME WAYS I CAN USE ELEVATE?

By seeking insights from people living with CF and/or their families through:

- Surveys
- Polls
- Interviews
- Focus groups
- Document reviews
- Etc.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF PROJECT REQUESTORS TO USE ELEVATE?

Your project should:

- Include an opportunity for feedback/input from the CF community
- Aim to positively impact the Canadian CF community
- Gather information that is relevant and meaningful to the CF community
- Be sensitive to the CF community's needs and concerns at the time
- Communicate in English, French or both languages
- Include a plan for sharing the results with the Elevate team

For your project to be considered for review by the Elevate team, you must complete the Elevate Project Request Form approximately 3-4 weeks in advance of your project start date.
